## SHOUTOUTS

- Made his Bills debut vs. Tennessee (9/19/22), playing the fourth quarter in the Bills 41-7 win.
- Has rushed 143 times for 450 yards, six touchdowns and 54 first downs.
- Last season with Cleveland, started 2-of-7 games played and completed 65.3% of his passes for 462 yards, three TDs and one INT. Tallied a passer rating of 91.3
- With Minnesota in 2017, started 14-of-15 games played and tallied an 11-3 record in games he started. Completed 67.6% of his passes for 22 touchdowns, seven INTs and a career-high 98.3 passer rating.
- During the 2017 playoffs, helped lead the Vikings to the NFC Championship. Against NO (1/14/18) completed 25-of-40 attempts for one touchdown and an interception in a 29-24 win and then at Phi. (1/21/18) completed 28-of-48 attempts for one TD and two INTs.
- Finished his college career at Houston as the NCAA all-time leader in total passing yards (19,217) and passing touchdowns (155).



## FIRST-AND-10

**CASE KEENUM** joins the Bills in 2022 after spending the last two seasons with the Browns (2020-21). Keenum originally entered the NFL as an undrafted free agent in 2012 with the Houston Texans where he played until 2014. Keenum has also played for the Rams (2014-16), Vikings (2017), Broncos (2018) and Washington (2019).

### A MINNEAPOLIS MIRACLE

Case Keenum and Stefon Diggs won't need much time to get reacquainted in the Bills locker room. Back in January 2018, the duo connected on a 61-yard game winning touchdown in the playoffs that became dubbed the Minneapolis Miracle. "God is so good," Keenum said after the game. "It's probably gonna go down as the third best moment of my life; behind giving my life to Jesus Christ, marrying my wife, and this one's right there close."

"I just threw it to the sideline. I remember I lost vision of him a little bit behind my right guard and I couldn't really see. I knew the ball came out of my hand really, really well. Sometimes it comes out good, and this came out great — I knew it was right where I wanted to put it. But I couldn't see where Stefon was. And all of a sudden I see Stefon's hands, his white gloves, just coming out of nowhere, and I'm like, 'He's gonna catch this ball.' And he catches it."

Married to Kimberly and the couple has a son. Received his bachelor's degree in kinesiology with a minor in business administration from Houston in 2010. Also participated in track & field and basketball in high school.
