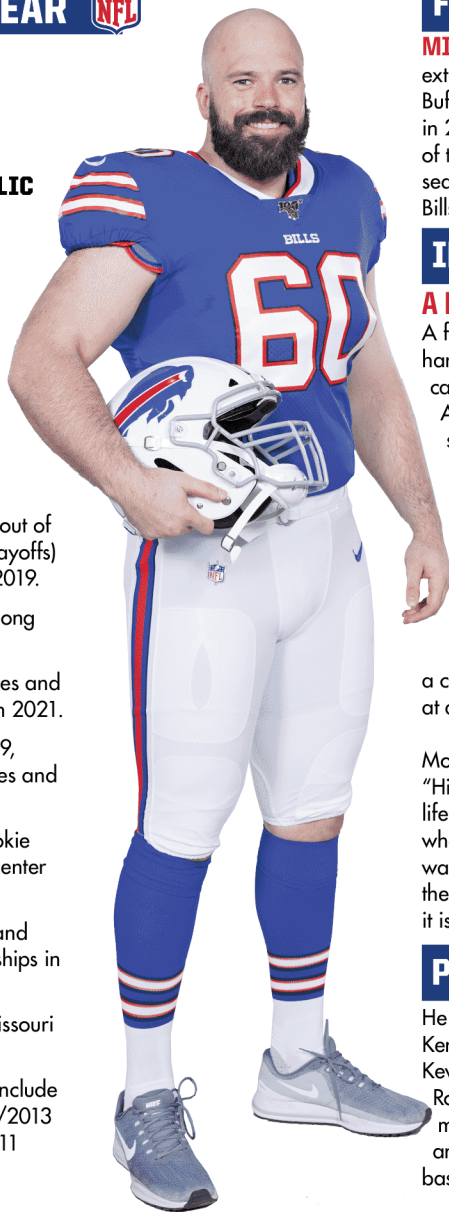

SHOUTOUTS

- Started and played in his 100th regular season game vs. Pit. (10/9/22).
- Including playoffs, has started 57 out of a possible 60 games (including playoffs) at center since joining the Bills in 2019.
- Voted by teammates as a season-long team captain for the Bills in 2022.
- Started all 17 regular season games and both playoff contests for the Bills in 2021.
- In his first season in Buffalo in 2019, started all 16 regular season games and one playoff game.
- Named to the 2015 PFWA All-Rookie Team, after starting 15 games at center for the Chiefs.
- Helped Mizzou to a 24-5 record and back-to-back SEC East Championships in his last two seasons.
- Started his final 38 games with Missouri at right tackle.
- College honors while at Missouri include 2014 Second-Team All-SEC, 2012/2013 SEC Academic Honor Roll and 2011 Academic All-Big 12 first team.



FIRST-AND-10

MITCH MORSE signed a two-year contract extension in 2022 that will keep him in Buffalo through 2024. He entered the NFL in 2015 as a 2nd round pick (49th overall) of the Chiefs. Morse spent the first four NFL seasons in Kansas City before joining the Bills as an unrestricted free agent in 2019.

A HARSH REALITY

A four-year-old Morse was forced into a harsh reality breaking him from what he called "a life of rainbows and pizza." On April 1, 1996, Morse's brother, Robbie, suffered a debilitating brain injury after being violently shaken by a babysitter. Despite the life-altering tragedy, Morse feels that he wouldn't be the same person today without having gone through the experience. "I have soft spots. I don't think I would be quite the person I am today without that tragedy happening to my brother. People say it's a cross to bear, but he hasn't been a burden at all. He's been a blessing," Morse said.

Morse's father, Kevin, told the Buffalo News, "His brother grounds him in the reality of life. Mitch has always been somebody who's been part of the solution. I think it was a Brazilian philosopher who said that the blessing is very near the wound. And it is."

GIVING BACK

During the beginning of the Covid-19 crisis in 2020, Morse and his wife, Caitlin, wanted to find a way to help the Buffalo community from afar. They decided to donate \$100,000 to FeedMore WNY, formerly Meals on Wheels and the Food Bank. "We couldn't give our services," Morse told the Buffalo News. "We couldn't go out and help in the community hands-on. So we decided that the best plan of action was to set aside a little bit of money to send to FeedMore."

CAPTAIN MITCH

Being named a season-long captain in 2022 for the first time in his NFL career was not taken lightly by Morse. "I was a little shocked to be honest. I feel like it's my greatest achievement as a player because it was voted on by teammates. The opinions of my peers are those that I care about the most." He credits former Bills TE Lee Smith for learning the intricacies of leadership as a player. "His ability to navigate the locker room as a whole during all sorts of situations is a special skill. He did it very, very well for a long time."

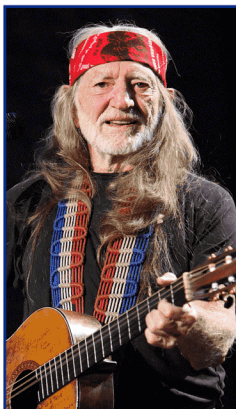
