- Has played in eight career NFL games. Played in four games in his rookie season in 2017, starting two, and played in four games in 2018, starting one game.

- Played in 46 games as a Wolverine with 37 starts on the offensive line as a four-year letterman.
- In 2016 at Michigan, started all 12 games at right tackle en route to earning All-Big Ten first-team recognition.
- He also earned the team's Hugh R. Rader Memorial Award, which recognizes the Wolverines best lineman.
