Terry Heffernan joined the Bills in 2019 after being hired as the team's assistant offensive line coach.

COACHING HIGHLIGHTS

2019-present: (Buffalo Bills)

- Helped oversee an offensive line that included four new starters.

2016-18: (Eastern Kentucky)

- Spent the 2016 and 2017 seasons as the assistant head coach and offensive line coach before being promoted to associate head coach and offensive line coach in 2018.
- Under Heffernan's leadership, the ECU ranked second in the Ohio Valley Conference in 2018 in rushing yards, finishing with 2,246 for the season.
- ECU led the conference and ranked seventh in the nation in time of possession in 2018, averaging 32:54.

2013-15: (Detroit Lions)

- Spent his the 2013 season as the assistant offensive line coach, served as the offensive quality control coach in 2014, and moved back to assistant offensive line in 2015.

2007-12: (Wayne State)

- Served as the team's offensive line coach for his first five seasons at Wayne State before moving to offensive

coordinator in 2012.

- Helped WSU to a school-record 12 wins and a NCAA Division II runner-up finish in 2011.

2005-07: (Michigan)

- Served as a graduate assistant under head coach Rich Rodriguez.

2004-05: (Louisville)

- Served as a graduate assistant under head coach Bobby Petrino.

- Graduated from Dayton with a degree in communications in 2003 and was a four-year student-athlete in football.
